**A. Background:**

Individuals who are fleeing felons are not eligible for CAPI. Individuals convicted of a drug felony are potentially eligible for CAPI.

**Purpose:**

This section is revised for the sunset review. No Program rules have changed.

**B. Policy:**

**1. Fleeing Felons:**

There is not CAPI eligibility for an individual who is:

- Fleeing to avoid prosecution, or custody or confinement after conviction for a crime which is a felony under the laws from which the individual flees
- Violating a condition of probation or parole imposed under federal or state law. However, the individual can reapply for CAPI after clearing the violation.

**2. Drug Felons:**

Convicted drug felons are eligible for CAPI.
