Background:

When a CalFresh applicant or recipient is getting their meals delivered through a Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) authorized program, such as Meals on Wheels, they may pay with CalFresh when they meet the criteria outlined below. This section has no updates after sunset review.

Purpose:

This section details the regulations regarding delivered meals.

Policy:

To be eligible to use CalFresh to buy delivered meals, a person must meet the following criteria:

- The recipient must be otherwise eligible for CalFresh and:
 - Living alone or only with a spouse; and
 - At least sixty years of age; or
 - Housebound, physically handicapped, or otherwise disabled to the extent that they are unable to adequately prepare all their meals.
- The recipient may not be a resident of a boarding house or institution;
- The meals must be purchased from a non-profit meal delivery service authorized by FNS to accept CalFresh.

If one member of a married couple qualifies for delivered meals, the spouse of the eligible individual may also purchase delivered meals with CalFresh, regardless of their age or disability.

Procedure:

Households must meet all other CalFresh Eligibility Criteria as stated in 63-250.
