Background:

CalFresh Employment & Training (CFET) components are designed to provide recipients training and work experience. San Diego’s CFET program consist of the following components: Education, Supervised Job Search (SJS), Job Retention, and Work Experience (WE) delivered by Work Activity and Work Based Learning.

Purpose:

The purpose of this section is to provide component definitions and the methods in which they are administered. This section is being revised to update the Workfare component to WE (Work Activity and Work Based Learning) and provide new guidance on transportation allowances.

Policy:

Components are administered directly by CFET Social Worker (SW) staff, additional services are contracted with San Diego Workforce Partnership (SDWP) and Fresh Success. The table below details the components offered by each provider:

Provider	Components Offered

1. CFET Delivery:

The method in which CFET services are provided are as follows:

Provider	Method of Delivery
CFET SW	Participants assigned to complete: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SJS are referred to SDWP Job Centers to fulfill the assignment • WE by means of Work Activity are referred to one of our community partners to fulfill the assignment
SDWP	SDWP delivers the following services: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SJS, Job Retention, and Education are provided in a classroom at one of San Diego County’s 6 Job Centers • WE by means of Work Based Learning is delivered through following sub-partners: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ International Rescue Committee Market Project/Mission Edge ○ Kitchens for Good ○ Dreams for Change

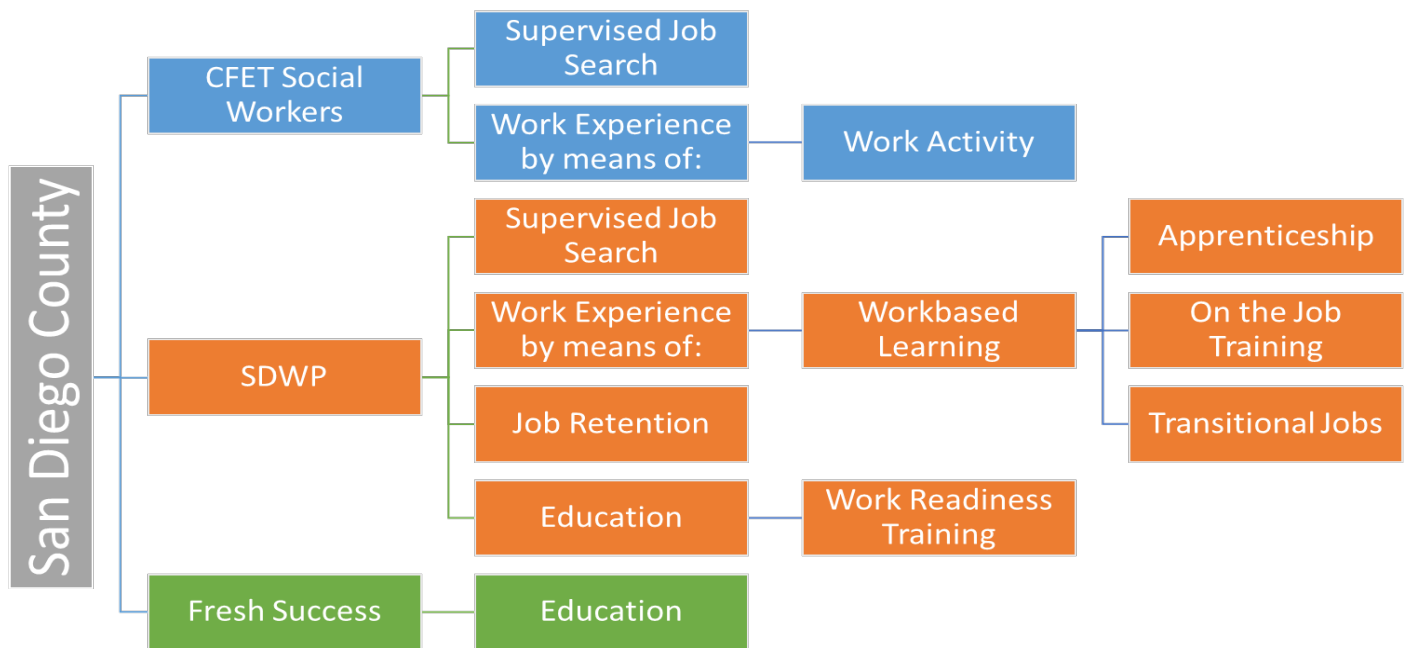

Fresh Success	Education services are delivered at community colleges by means of supportive services such as career counseling, interview training, job search, placement, and retention services.

Note: CalFresh recipients who chose to volunteer, can participate in one or more components concurrently.

2. CFET Summary:

3. Transportation Allowance:

CFET participants who do not have a means of transportation to commute to their assignments are eligible for transportation payments. Refer to CFET Transportation Payment Processing Guide 903-04 for system entry instructions.


