**Temporary Suspension of Transitional Nutrition Benefit (TNB)
Recertifications**

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Effective Date:

01/03/2022

Background:

Households (HH) eligible for the TNB Program will initially be certified for one 12-month period. Eligible TNB HHs will then be recertified for an additional six-month period. TNB cases discontinued for failure to provide could be restored during a 30-day time frame.

Purpose:

This special notice introduces a temporary suspension to all TNB recertifications for a minimum of two years.

Procedure:

Effective November 2021, all TNB recertifications will be suspended for a minimum of two years. HHs were notified of this temporary suspension using the Recertification Extension (TNB 9) mass mailer. The attached mass mailer was successfully generated and mailed out to TNB HHs on 10/11/2021.

Changes have been made to the Notice of Approval for TNB (TNB 2). The TNB 2 will now require manual variables to be entered for the notice to be released. Staff are reminded to review the print queue for any notices pending manual variables. An attempt must be made to contact HHs that lose TNB eligibility due to failure to provide and restore benefits within the new 90-day timeframe. Refer to CFPG 63-332.3.

In response to Assembly Bill 135, your TNB benefits will continue for 2 years beginning November 2021. This means that if your TNB recertification (TNB 4) is due November 2021 or after, you do not have to turn it in.

If your household has a change in income, and you think you may be eligible for CalFresh again, you can apply at any time. In 2 years, you will receive a TNB recertification form. Please call your county office or eligibility worker if you have any questions.
