

## 90-300.05. PERSONAL EFFECTS

---

- A. General** This section provides information regarding the treatment of personal effects in the GR Program.
- 
- B. Limit** The personal effects limit is \$250 per GR household. If the net market value of personal effects exceeds \$250, the applicant/recipient is ineligible to GR. The value of personal effects counts toward the overall property limit.
- 
- C. Exceptions** Personal effects include everything the applicant/recipient owns except:
- cash and liquid resources
  - motor vehicles
  - real property or motor vehicles used as the home
  - one burial reserve or burial trust per applicant/recipient
  - wedding and engagement rings
  - tools used for employment.
- 
- D. Documentation** Verification of item value and encumbrances is by applicant's/recipient's statement. However, if the statement conflicts with other information or if the value is within \$25 of the \$250 limit, appraisal of the major items by a dealer or specialist in the property items, an insurance adjuster, or a personal property appraiser is required.
